2010•ALPACA•WALKING•FLEECE *Fiber Futurity*

A Futurity is typically used to predict the stars of tomorrow. Open only to young animals, it is a way to judge or predict their potential impact on the next generation. Although conformation should never be disregarded, the Virginia Classic Alpaca Walking Fleece Fiber Futurity's goal is to focus specifically on fiber genetics.

A Virginia Classic Fiber Show Original Event

Judge: Cathy Songer

- \$50 per Entry
- Open to all Alpacas 6 to 18 month of age.
- No herd sire nomination required
- Entries must be received by Feb. 15.
- Entries limited to 75. First-come, first-served.
- Classes will be divided by breed and color.
- Premium award to the top three place per class. First - \$150; Second = \$100; Third - \$50.
- An overall "best in" futurity winner will be selected.
- Ribbons awarded through 6th place
- Classes with less than six entries will be combined.
- To be judged 100% on fiber on the animal. (Fineness, structure, hand, density, etc.) Alpacas must be in full fleece.
- A judging station will be set up for evaluation. You are responsible for getting your alpaca to the fiber futurity judging station within a given time frame. Please plan ahead and be aware of your classes in the halter ring.
- All alpacas must be judged by 5 p.m. Saturday, March 13. Judging will begin at 9 a.m. Saturday March 13. (Schedule is subject to change.)
- Awards will be presented during Saturday Night's dinner.
- The alpaca is not required to be entered in halter to be eligible for the futurity. This is not an AOBA event.
- Limit 6 entries per farm.

Classes

Huacayas 6 to 18 months old (Born 9/14/08 to 9/13/09)

- H1. Black (BB, TB)
- H2. Brown (LB, MB, DB)
- H3. Fawn (LF, MF, DF.)
- H4 Light (W, BE)
- H5 Grey (LSG, MSG, DSG, LRG, MRG, DRG)
- H6 Multicolored (Indefinite, Paint, Fancy, Appaloosa)

Suris 6 to 18 months old (Born 9/14/08 to 9/13/09)

- S1. Dark (MF, DF, LB, MB, DB, BB, DB)
- S2. Light (W, BE, LF)
- S3. Multicolored (Grey, Indefinite, Paint, Fancy, Appaloosa)

Judging will take place from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday. Although you may bring your alpacas up at any time, it is your responsibility to have your animal evaluated prior to 5 p.m. and to avoid conflict with the alpaca halter ring. I recommend bringing your fawn animals up early in the day as well as alpacas being shown on Sunday. Black and brown alpacas can be brought up after their halter classes are complete.
