Level III Alpaca Show

- All classes will be governed by the current AOBA Show Division handbook. Only halter classes with 16 or more entries will be divided further. Suri classes may be combined based on proper combining rules.
- All alpacas entered in the halter classes must be in full fleece.
- BVD PCR (or VI prior to 1/1/2010) negative test for all alpacas will be required for entry on to the Virginia Horse Center grounds. You must have test results included on your health papers.
- All alpacas attending the show, even those not competing, must be at least 6 months of age, ARI registered, microchipped and have health papers issued within 30 days of the last day of the show. The alpaca's ARI name and microchip number must be listed on the health papers. Out-of-state alpacas must be tested and found negative for blue tongue, brucellosis and TB. A copy of ALL health papers must be provided for the show office to keep on permanent record. Copies of ARI certificates must be sent with your entries.
- Exhibitors are required to complete and sign an Exhibitor's Disclosure Statement to be submitted with their show entry form.
- Entries in the Get of Sire or Produce of Dam are made in the name of the Sire/Dam. A copy of the Sire/Dam ARI certificate must be provided along with the names of the alpacas showing in the class and the name(s) of their owners. Sire/Dam is not required to attend event.
- All alpacas entered in group classes must be eligible and entered in their respective halter class. No fee is required for group classes.
- Youth age divisions are based on age of handler as of January 1, 2010 Sub Jr-under 8, Junior 8-11, Intermediate 12-15, Senior 16-19 Note; Classes may be combined depending on the number of entrants for each class
- All halter, showmanship and performance class entries must be made by the entry deadline. No additions will be accepted at the show. Only group and sub-junior classes may be added at the show.

Entry Fees

- Entry fee per alpaca is \$50 for up to five classes
- Additional classes are \$15 each
- AOBA Fee \$6 per alpaca
- Stalls and tacks stalls \$50 each (limit 3 to a stall)
- AOBA Show Division Non-member Fee \$75 per farm per show.

Alpaca Classes

- There must be a minimum of 10 huacaya entries, or 8 suri entries, per gender per color group for a Color Champion to be awarded. Classes may be combined and/or further split after all entries are received.
- Alpaca Exhibitor rule applies: No breeder may enter more than three alpacas per breed per color designation per age division per gender.
- All halter entries must be in full fleece and the last shearing date, if applicable, **must** be provided.
- All alpacas entered in halter classes **must arrive** no later than 7 p.m. on Friday, March 12, 2010.

Premiums

Printed premiums and awards are subject to change. Show management reserves the right to withhold the payment of premi-

ums to any exhibitor with an outstanding balance. Premiums will be issued within 30 days of the show. Premiums will be awarded to color champions and reserves only.

Surgery

If your alpaca has required an AOBA-acceptable surgery, a letter from your vet **must** be presented with your entries.

Show Vet and EMT

Both a veterinarian and an EMT will be available throughout the show for the safety of you and your animals. Vet charges must be negotiated between the vet and exhibitor.

T-shirts and Sweatshirts

The Virginia Classic T-shirts and sweatshirts will be (color pending) this year. T-shirts (100% cotton) are \$15; sweatshirts (80/20 blend) are \$25; Hooded sweatshirts are \$30. Sweatshirts must be ordered by Feb. 15 - no extras will be ordered. A limited number of extra T-shirts will be available at the show.

Refunds

Show Cancellation: In the unlikely event the show is cancelled due to weather, The Virginia Classic exhibitors' entry fees will be reimbursed up to 75%. A blizzard forecast, or other severe winter weather forecast, would be the only reason for cancellation. Should it be necessary to cancel the show due to hazardous weather conditions, every attempt will be made to notify exhibitors no later than March 13th. **Refunds will be made only if the show is cancelled.**

The show **cannot** promise refunds due to individual weather or personal problems.

Weather

March is unpredictable. You won't likely need fans to keep your alpacas comfortable. The nights are usually chilly if not cold. Expect highs during the day to be anywhere from 40° - 60°. Be sure to pack something warm and dry to wear. Current weather conditions are available on the web site. (www.llamalife.com/classic)

Medical Waste

ALL medical waste (needles, syringes, etc.) must be discarded in the appropriate containers located in each barn. **DO NOT** discard medical waste in stalls, manure pits, garbage cans or on the grounds.

Bio-Security

The Virginia Horse Center is one of the most bio-secure facilities you will occupy throughout your show calendar, as the stalling restricts animal contact with neighboring stalls. Please use common sense and courtesy when walking your animals around common areas.

Stalling

Panels extending from your stalls will be permitted with outside facing stalls **ONLY**. If you wish to put panels up in front of your stall, please make this request on your entry form.

Stalling will be assigned and arranged on a first-come, first-served basis according to postmark. The earlier the postmark, the closer you will be placed to the coliseum. The stalls are 10' x 12' stationary horse stalls. Three sides are solid and roughly 8' high. The front is an open metal grid with sliding doors. The floors are dirt and electricity is available to each stall.

Bedding - Bedding is **required**. Mats, carpeting, shavings, kenaf pellets, cardboard bedding and straw are acceptable. Sod, sand, sawdust and newspaper are **not** permitted. Straw, shavings and cardboard bedding may be available for purchase. Please contact the Horse Center prior to arrival for pricing and availability.

Fees: All stalls are \$50. **Maximum capacity** for any stall is three (3) animals. Farms housing more than three animals to a stall will be charged \$50 for each stall violating occupancy rules.

Farm Displays - You will be allowed 3 feet out from the stalls for display purposes. Farm displays are encouraged. Indoor farm display space inside the coliseum is also available for \$125. (Ideal for those who wish to participate without bringing animals.)

Tack Stalls - Tack stalls are the same as standard show stalls and cost \$50. If you choose to share a tack stall with other exhibitors, please indicate who you'll be sharing with on your entry form so you will be stalled together.

Manure - All manure and used bedding from stalls or trailers must be placed in the designated areas. **DO NOT** discard manure in garbage cans. Stalls do not need to be cleaned before leaving.

Pets

All pets must be kept on a maximum 6' leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility. This is a county ordinance. Failure to comply will result in notifying Animal Control. **No pets** are allowed in the coliseum or in any office at any time.

Camper Hookup

Reservations will not be accepted. You'll pay for camper hook-up upon arrival. Water and electric. The horse center has 90 hook-up

sites, so availability should not be a problem. Contact the Horse Center directly with questions concerning a camper hook-ups.

Arrivals/Departures

You may arrive any time on Friday after 12:00 p.m. and before 10:00 p.m.. There shall be no arrivals between the hours of midnight and 7:00 am. If you need to arrive early or depart late contact Paige at 434-286-4494 to make arrangements. Additional fees may apply.

Security

There will be security guards on duty throughout the show. Please be sure to lock your vehicles and secure your valuables. The Virginia Classic is not responsible for loss of any kind.

The Virginia Classic Conduct Code

Show management reserves the right to disqualify and/or remove any exhibitor who behaves in a manner deemed improper, unethical, dishonest, unsportsmanlike or intemperate. Including but not limited to mistreatment of animals, or any comment or remark made in connection with the show considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the character or integrity of the judging, show management, show volunteers, sponsors or other exhibitors.

Show Program Advertising

2010 Mandatory Exhibitor Disclosure

Under the Show Division Handbook Rules, certain alpacas and fleeces are automatically disqualified from competition and certain Exhibitors & Handlers are prohibited from personally showing in front of a Judge when a business or financial relationship exists between an AOBA Certified Judge and their customers.

Each year at contract renewal time, our Judges are required to disclose those alpacas, exhibitors and handlers who cannot be shown in their show ring when judging at an AOBA Certified show. Exhibitors are also required to disclose business and financial relationships with Judges and to acknowledge animals/fleece entered into the competitions that are not allowed to show in front of certain Judges at each show they attend. This is being done to ensure Exhibitors understand the written rules and to eliminate confusion for Exhibitors & Handlers about which alpacas, Exhibitors & Handlers cannot walk into a Judge's show ring during competition and which fleeces can not be entered into a Fleece Show.
