

The Virginia Classic Handmades Derby™ Fiber Arts Show

Entry Fee is \$10 per item
(handmade and skein)

- *Handmades and skeins may be mailed in, but **must** be received by March 9 or on the show grounds no later than 6 p.m. March 12.*

All entries must be made using yarn or fiber that is at least 50 percent llama and/or alpaca. Yarn used in knitted, crocheted, woven or felted projects may be handspun or commercially spun. All entries must be received for judging by 6 p.m. Friday, March 12. Once judged, all items will be on display throughout the show and may be picked up after noon on Sunday. If you do not plan to attend the show in person, or will not be arriving at the show by then, please mail in your entries. Entries from across the country may be mailed in as long as return postage is included. Ribbons will be awarded and a "Best in Show" will be recognized in each division (youth, novice and advanced).

If there is not enough room on the entry tag, please include a 3x5 card with each entry describing the article: whether the yarn is handspun or commercially spun; percentage of llama and/or alpaca wool; percentage and type of other fiber added if applicable; any special techniques used...

Divisions for the Handmades Derby are: **Youth, 18** years and under; **Novice Adult**, knitters/weavers/felters with less than two year's experience; **Advanced Adult**, experienced and/or professional knitters/weavers/felters. Each fiber artist may enter up to two items per class. Some classes may be combined within a division depending on entries received.

Handspun Skeins (1 oz min.):

Skeins must be 2-ply and weigh at least one ounce. The yarn should be wound on a two yard niddy-noddy and gently figure eight-tied in four places. Do not twist into a tight skein; leave hanging loosely. May be dyed. If dyed, must be hand dyed. Include intended use in your description.

100% llama and/or alpaca
